

MIGUEL DAJER'S RAIL MOUNTING SYSTEM FOR THE ARQEN LEANFUSER & LEANFRACTAL DIFFUSER

WARNING: Take any mounting recommendations with a grain of salt, as only you know the specifics of your build. Ensuring safe mounting is your responsibility. If in doubt, consult someone knowledgeable about hanging heavy objects, such as a structural engineer, cabinet maker or installer.

Here's a French cleat/rail mounting system for the Arqen Leanfuser or Leanfractal diffuser. Mounting rails are firmly secured to the wall studs, and diffuser modules are hung off the rails with a French cleat.

This was built by Miguel Dajer. Here are his comments:

Mounting method: a simple dual rail system. Lift and drop on the groove of the rails. The main difficulty is ensuring good fit between the wall mounting rails and the anchor on the back of the diffusers. We cut mounting grooves at a 45 degree angle for best and easiest fit.
